Õppe eesmärk on toetada noore valmidust kutseõpingute jätkamisel või tööle asumisel.

Õppe läbimisel oskavad noored valida teadlikumalt sobivat eriala või asuda tööle.

The study aims to support the young person's readiness to continue vocational studies or start working.

By completing their studies, young people can more consciously choose a suitable speciality or start a job.

25.08.2021 toimus intervjuu seoses projektiga "**Kutsevaliku õppe rakendamine kutseõppeasutustes**" Pärnumaa Kutsehariduskeskuses. Hetkel on käimas Euroopa majanduspiirkonna ja Norra toetuste kohaliku arengu programmide vahehindamine abisaajariikides. Vahehindamist juhivad Blomeyer & Sanz (www.blomeyer.eu), CREDA Consulting ning Eesti partneriks on Balti Uuringute Instituut (www.ibs.ee). Pärnumaa Kutsehariduskeskuse projekt on samuti osa uuringu valimist. Intervjuul vesteldi teemadel: meie kooli nägemus projekti mõjust, hinnang senisele arengule, kogemused koostööst projektipartnerite ja sihtrühmaga, seosed kohalike arengustrateegiatega ning meie arvamus EMP ja Norra toetuste kasulikkusest ja potentsiaalidest.

On 25.08.2021, an interview was conducted concerning the project "**Implementation of vocational education in vocational education institutions**" project at Pärnumaa Vocational Education Center. An interim evaluation of the European Economic Area and Norwegian grants' local development programs are underway in the recipient countries. The provisional assessment is managed by Blomeyer & Sanz (www.blomeyer.eu), CREDA Consulting, and the Estonian partner is the Institute of Baltic Studies (www.ibs.ee). The Pärnumaa Vocational Education Center project is also part of the study selection. During the interview, the following topics were discussed:

- Our school's vision of the impact of the project
- Assessment of the development so far
- Experiences of cooperation with project partners and the target group
- Connections with local development strategies
- Our opinion on the usefulness and potential of EEA and Norwegian support

04.08.2021 osalesime **Tori valla täiskasvanud õppija päeval**, kus tutvustasime õppimisvõimalusi meie koolis. Toimusid ka teenindusõppeosakonna poolt korraldatud kaubanduse-, teeninduse-, koka- ja pagari töötoad.

Õppenõustaja Marina Skljarenko ja õppe- ja karjäärinõustaja Kersti Karu on arendanud pidevalt koostöösuhteid ametiasutustega ning osalenud võrgustikutöös. Näiteks osales õppenõustaja Sotsiaalkindlustusameti eestvedamisel "Ringist välja" programmis, mille eesmärgiks oli õpimotivatsiooni hoidmine ning õpiabi pakkumine.

On 04.08.2021, we participated in the **adult learner's day of Tori municipality**, where we introduced learning opportunities in our school. Trade, service, cooking and baking workshops organized by the service education department also occurred.

Study counsellor Marina Skljarenko and study and career counsellor Kersti Karu have continuously developed cooperative relations with authorities and participated in networking. For example, the study counsellor participated in the "Out of the Circle" program under the Social Insurance Board's leadership to maintain study motivation and provide support.

29.10.2021 osaleti võrgustikus "**HEV õppija distantsõppel**". Korraldaja: Astangu Kutserehabilitatsiooni Keskus. Seminaril jagati distantsõppe õnnestumisi ja väljakutseid.

06.05.2021 toimus Astangul **HEV võrgustiku** kohtumine, kus Töötukassa spetsialistid rääkisid oma teenustest: karjäärinõustamisest ja tugiteenustest 16-aastastele erivajadustega noortele. Astangu tööhõivespetsialistid jagasid oma kogemust, kuidas kutseõppe õppijatele praktikakohti leida ja kuidas toetada nende praktikale ja tööle rakendumist.

On 29.10.2021, the "**Special need learner's distance learning**" network participated. Organizer: Astangu Vocational Rehabilitation Center: shared successes and challenges of distance learning at the seminar.

On 06.05.2021, a meeting of **the Special need network** took place in Astangu, where the specialists of the Unemployment Insurance Fund talked about their services: career counselling and support services for 16-year-old youth with special needs. Astangu's employment specialists shared their experience on how to find internships for vocational students and how to support their application to internships and work.

2021/22. õppeaastal avasime kutsevaliku õppekaval (30 EKAP) kaks õpperühma: KARU21s ja KARU-22. KARU-21s õpperühm alustas 12 õpilasega õppetööd 12. oktoobril. Õpilased omandasid teadmisi arvutiõpetuses, eesti keeles, matemaatikas, loovtöodes, majutus- ja toitlustusteeninduses, suhtlemise alustes, õpioskustes, õpitee planeerimises jt. Lisaks toimus õpilaste järjepidev individuaalne toetamine ja nõustamine. Novembris toimus KARU-21s õppeekskursioon mooduli „Majutus- ja toitlustusteenindaja“ õppetundide raames Tori hobusekasvandusse ja C. R. Jakobsoni talumuuseumisse.

2021/22. in the academic year, we opened two study groups in the vocational selection curriculum (30 EKAP): KARU21s and KARU-22. KARU-21's study group started studies with 12 students on October 12. Students acquired knowledge in computer education, the Estonian language, mathematics, creative works, accommodation and catering services, communication basics, study skills, learning path planning, etc. In addition, there was consistent individual support and counselling of students. In November, KARU-21 took part in an educational excursion to the Tor horse farm and the C. R. Jakobson farm museum as part of the lessons of the "Accommodation and catering service" module.

Õpperühma lõpuaktus toimus 20.04.2022 ja lõputunnistuse said seitse õpilast ning üks õpilane jätkas õppimist KARU-22 rühmas. Rühmajuhatajaks oli alati rõõmsameelne Malle Kallus.

The graduation ceremony of the study group took place on 20.04.2022, seven students received their graduation certificates, and one student continued his studies in the KARU-22 group. The always cheerful Malle Kallus was the group leader.

KARU-22 õpperühma 15 õpilast alustasid õppetööd 02.02.2022. Veebruari lõpus liitus õpperühmaga ka üheksa Ukrainast pärit noort sõjapõgenikku, mille tulemusena kasvas õppijate arv rühmas 24.

Õpilased omandasid teadmisi arvutiõpetuses, eesti keeles, matemaatikas, loovtöodes, majutus- ja toitlustusteeninduses, suhtlemise alustes, õpioskustes, õpitee planeerimises, laotöös, tiseri õppes, majanduses ja tööõiguses. Uussisserändajad õppisid eesti keelt mahus 10 EKAP. Lisaks toimus õpilaste järjepidev individuaalne toetamine ja nõustamine.

Õpetaja ja rühmajuhataja Malle Kalluse eestvedamisel osalesid õpilased ka mitmetes töötubades, näiteks keraamika töötoas, millele andsid õpilased väga positiivse tagasiside.

Fifteen students of the KARU-22 study group started their studies on 02.02.2022. At the end of February, nine young war refugees from Ukraine also joined the study group, as a result of which the number of learners in the group increased to 24.

The students acquired knowledge in computer education, the Estonian language, mathematics, creative works, accommodation and food service, communication basics,

study skills, learning path planning, warehouse work, carpentry studies, economics and labour law. New immigrants learned Estonian in the amount of 10 EKAP. In addition, there was consistent individual support and counselling of students.

Under the leadership of teacher and group leader Malle Kallus, the students also participated in several workshops, such as the ceramics workshop, to which the students gave very positive feedback.

23.05.–03.06.2022 viibisid Pärnumaa kutsehariduskeskuse kutsevaliku õppekava õpetajad ja KARU-22 õpperühma õpilased kogemuste vahetamise eesmärgil Riia Turismi- ja tööstuskoolis. Projekti Erasmus+ eesmärgiks oli Eesti kutsevaliku ja Läti toitlustusteeninduse erialade õpetajate ja õpilaste kogemuste vahetus; Eesti, Läti ja Ukraina õpilaste koostöö ja erialade tutvustamine; õpilaste keelepraktika; Läti kultuuriga ja rahvustoitudega tutvumine; koostöö arendamine Läti, Leedu õpetajatega järgnevaks eTwinningu projektiks; tutvumine Läti kutsekooli õppekorraldusega ja praktiliste tundidega.

From 23.05.–03.06.2022, the teachers of the vocational selection curriculum of the Pärnumaa Vocational Education Center and the students of the KARU-22 study group stayed at the Riga School of Tourism and Industry to exchange experiences.

The aim of the Erasmus+ project was the exchange of experiences of teachers and students of Estonian vocational choice and Latvian food service specialities; Cooperation between Estonian, Latvian and Ukrainian students and introduction of majors; students' language practice; Getting to know Latvian culture and national dishes; developing cooperation with Latvian, Lithuanian teachers for the next eTwinning project; familiarization with the study organization and practical classes of the Latvian vocational school.

Mida õpiti välislähetusest

Tutvuti Läti kultuuriga ja osaleti erinevatel õppekäikudel, mida saatis giid. Degusteeriti vabaõhumuuseumis perenaise poolt valmistatud rahvusköögi toite. Õpetajatel oli võimalus võrrelda enda oskuseid ja praktikaid teiste koolidega ja seeläbi silmaringi arendada, samuti võrrelda õppekõikide sisustust, õppekorraldust, meetodikat.

The foreign mission.

We got acquainted with Latvian culture and participated in various study tours accompanied by a guide. They tasted the national cuisine in the open-air museum. The teachers had the opportunity to compare their skills and practices with other schools and thereby develop their horizons, as well as compare the furnishings of the teaching kitchens, teaching organization and methodology.

Õpperühma KARU-22 lõpuaktus toimus 21.06.2022 ja lõputunnistuse said kaheksa õpilast, üheksale ukraina õpilasele väljastati tõendid kutsevaliku õppekaval õppe läbimise

kohta. Mitmed õpilased jätkavad meie koolis oma õpiteed: kaks õpilast LT-22, üks õpilane AT-22, üks õpilane PK-22, üks õpilane TT-22 õpperühmas. Seitse ukraina õpilast jätkavad õppimist KARU-22U1 õpperühmas.

The graduation ceremony of the study group KARU-22 took place on 21.06.2022; and eight students received a graduation certificate, nine Ukrainian students were issued certificates of completion of the vocational selection curriculum. Several students continue their studies at our school: two students in LT-22, one student in AT-22, one student in PK-22, and one student in the TT-22 study group. Seven Ukrainian students continue their studies in the KARU-22U1 study group.

12.06.2022 kinnitati EHISes uus **kutsevaliku õppekava mahuga 60 EKAP** ning alustasime 2022/23. õppeaastaks vastuvõttu uuele kutsevaliku õppekavale.

On 12.06.2022, a new **vocational selection curriculum with a volume of 60 EKAP** was approved in EHIS, and we started 2022/23—admission to the new vocational selection curriculum for the academic year.

Astangu keskus alustas 2021. aasta algusest uue arendusprojekti „**Kutserehabilitatsiooni teenuse disain**“ elluviimisega, mille partneriks on ka Pärnumaa kutsehariduskeskus. Projekti eesmärgiks on luua erivajadustega inimeste vajadustest lähtuvalt sobilik teenus tööoskuste õppimiseks. Projekti läbiviimise kontaktisikuks ja koordinaatoriks on meie koolis **Terje Jürivete**. Kool katsetab kutserehabilitatsiooni teenuse osutamist ukrainlaste kutsevaliku õppekava (KARU-22U2) õpperühmas ja KARU-22s õpperühmas perioodil juuni-august 2022 kuni juuni 2023. Projekt viiakse ellu Euroopa Sotsiaalfondi programmi meetme

„Töövõimereformi sihtrühma töövõimelisuse tõstmine ja nende töötamise soodustamine“ vahenditest.

At the beginning of 2021, the Astangu Center started implementing a new development project, "**Vocational Rehabilitation Service Design**", with Pärnumaa Vocational Education Center as a partner. The project aims to create a convenient service for learning work skills based on the needs of people with special needs. **Terje Jürivete** is the contact person and coordinator for implementing the project at our school. The school is testing the provision of vocational rehabilitation services in the vocational selection curriculum study group for Ukrainians (KARU-22U2) and in the KARU-22 study group from June-August 2022 to June 2023. The project is implemented as a measure of the European Social Fund program

"Increasing the working capacity of the target group of the work capacity reform and encouraging them to work" from the funds.

20.01.2022 toimus koostöökohtumine **Hiumaa ametikooli** esindajatega seoses projekti „Kutsevaliku õppe rakendamine kutseõppeasutustes“ raames. Hiumaa ametikool on meie projektipartneriks.

On 20.01.2022, a cooperation meeting with representatives of **Hiumaa Vocational School** regarding the project.

In the framework of "Implementation of vocational education in vocational education institutions",. Hiumaa Vocational School is our project partner.

05.- 06.01.2022, Pärnumaa Vocational Education Center hosted methodology days and various workshops as part of it. Terje Jürivete, in cooperation with the education coordinators of students with special educational needs at Rääma elementary school and Vanalinna elementary school and representatives of the unemployment fund, organized the workshop "**Intermediate vocational school - HEV student in general education school and the labour market**"

On January 13 of the 2022/23 academic year, 14 students of the KARU-23 study group started their studies in the vocational selection curriculum (30 EKAP). KARU-23 group leader is studying advisor **Marina Tiirik**.

Õpilased omandavad teadmisi eesti keeles, matemaatikas, laotöös, suhtlemise alustes, õpioskustes, õpitee planeerimises, pagar-kondiitri tehnoloogias, tislari õppes jt. Lisaks toimub õpilaste järjepidev individuaalne toetamine ja nõustamine.

05.10.2022 toimus kohtumine projekti "Kutsevaliku õppe rakendamine Pärnumaa Kutsehariduskeskuses " projekti rahastajatega. „**Kohalik areng ja vaesuse vähendamine**“ juhtkomisjoni koosoleku ühe osana külastati ka meie kooli. 16.01.2023 - a cooperation meeting of pilot schools (VOCO, Vana-Vigala TTK, Haapsalu Vocational Education Center, TEKO, Tallinna Kopli Vocational School, Ida-Virumaa Vocational Education Center, Pärnumaa Vocational Education Center) of the project "Testing Vocational Rehabilitation Services in Vocational Education" was held (Pärnumaa KHKgi1N Pärnumaa KHKgi2). The topic of the one-on-one meeting was the transmission of information about learning opportunities and specialties, and in this connection we introduced the admission process of our school's vocational selection plan and how we have reached the target group.

23.01.2023 - Meeting with the 9th grade students of Sauga Primary School. There was an introduction to the school, including the introduction of the curriculum of vocational choice.

26.01.2023 - we participated in the seminar on the introduction of additional education and the study analysis of vocational choice, which was conducted by Keiu Talve, the project manager of Astangu KHKs.

27.01.2023 - Lihula High School students with SEN together with their parents visited the Vocational Selection curriculum and the school.

10.02.2023 - Kuninga Tänan Primary School 9th year meeting with the class. There was a presentation of the vocational selection curriculum to teachers, parents and students. Helke Heinmets and Terje Jürivete participated

13.02.2023 - Meeting with the students of the III grade of Rääma Primary School. There was a presentation of the vocational selection curriculum to teachers, parents and students. Helke Heinmets and Terje Jürivete participated

22.02.2023 - an interview was held with Karmen Trasberg, lecturer in educational organization of the Institute of Educational Sciences of the University of Tartu and head of the vocational teacher curriculum, on the topic: "Implementation of vocational education in Estonian vocational schools". The aim was to better reflect the topic of vocational education in the preparation of vocational teachers, in this situation mapping is extremely important as an input.

20.03.2023 - an on-site inspection of the project "Implementation of vocational education in Pärnumaa Vocational Education Center and Hiiumaa Vocational School" took place, RTK coordinator, HTM Marit Kuusk participated.

10.04.2023 - a seminar of the network of support specialists was held at the Astangu Vocational Rehabilitation Center. The discussion took place on the topic - Implementation of the learning path module for SEN learners. We shared our experience of creating and implementing the Learning Path module of the vocational selection curriculum.

18.04.2023 - Presentation of PKHK specialties to the students of Vändra Gymnasium, including presentation of the curriculum of vocational choice.

19.04.2023 – Introduction of PKHK specialties to the students of Pärnu Ülejõe Primary School, including the introduction of the curriculum of vocational choice.

21.04.2023 – Häädemeeste Middle School - Introduction of PKHK specialties, including the introduction of the vocational selection curriculum.

10.05.2023 - Tartu School of Arts students of the professional selection curriculum visited our school - 12 students of the professional selection curriculum and 25 Ukrainians. The director gave an overview of our school in the auditorium, organized a tour. There was also a discussion on the subject of the vocational selection curriculum and mutual experiences. The students also participated in a fruit design workshop organized by teacher Taisi Talviste. The students got to know each other and a discussion took place. The conversation was led by Annika Kohv. A total of 42 people visited us.

11.05.2023 - 16 students and 4 teachers of the Saaremaa Inclusive Education Center getting to know the learning opportunities of our school and the vocational curriculum.

15.05.2023 - Meeting of pilot schools (Astangu KRK project) at Vana-Vigala Technical and Service School. Terje Jürivete gave a presentation, introducing our school's vocational curriculum and its implementation. The discussion took place on the topic of what are the possibilities for new changes/additions in supporting learners or a more learner-friendly reception or organization of studies.

25.05.2023 - the final seminar of the project "Implementation of Vocational Education in Pärnumaa Vocational Education Center and Hiiumaa Vocational School" was held. The event took place in Pernova Loodusmaja, and project partners were invited to participate (representatives of the local government, Töötukassa, RTK, teachers and group leaders of our school's vocational curriculum, counselors, director, project manager, project coordinator, marketing and communication manager). The seminar provided an overview of the project's budget and reporting (PKHK project coordinator) and content activities (PKHK learning and support service manager). A discussion took place - the implementation and sustainability of the vocational selection curriculum.

06.06.2023 - outreach work to reach the target group - all Pärnu County local governments, Youth Centers, HUUB, Pärnu City Government, Unemployment Fund.

14.06.2023 - participation in the information session of HTM education leaders, where one of the topics was the renewal of the vocational education curriculum, in connection with the reform of vocational education.

19.06.2023 - A student of Märjamaa Gymnasium together with a parent went to get acquainted with the vocational selection curriculum and the school.

25.10.2023 - a vocational training development seminar organized by HTM took place in Tallinn, where there was an opportunity to jointly conceptualize vocational training and map the development scenarios of vocational training. We shared today's experiences in order to jointly shape vocational education development scenarios in the context of raising the age of compulsory education. Purpose: to map the development scenarios of vocational education in the context of raising the compulsory education age.

08.11.2023 - Education director Lya Männiste from Tallinn School of Construction visited. The purpose of the cooperation meeting was topics/activities related to the vocational selection curriculum: admission, curriculum modules and their addition, etc.

09.11.2023 - the vocational selection curriculum was introduced and experience was shared with Liisbet Terni and Kaire Lattiku, employees of Astangu KHKS, who are both senior teachers of the field of study supporting social coping and are responsible for the teaching of vocational selection groups. The guests also observed the classes of students studying in the vocational choice curriculum (carpentry and vocational choice immersion course lessons).

15.12.2023 - Presentation of the curriculum and learning opportunities for vocational choice to students and teachers of Pärnu Tammsaare School.

08.01.2024 - an interview was held with Astangu KHKS employee Kai Raku (head of the study area supporting social coping) and teachers of our professional selection

curriculum, who use LAK teaching in lessons. We shared our experience of how the integrated classes take place in terms of language learning. The wish of the Astangu KHKS employee was to map the language teaching experience of subject teachers in vocational schools.

10.01.2024 – A cooperation meeting of the career education coordinators of the Pärnumaa schools and the career counselors of the Unemployment Fund was held at the Vocational Education Center of Pärnumaa. The topics were the presentation of the career counseling booking calendar and future events (fair, Tuleviku Tuur, etc.). Help materials were introduced (minukarjäär.ee, töutukassa YouTube channel, e-materials). Helke Heinmets introduced the goals of the project and vocational selection study, and we talked about its positive and negative aspects, innovations, etc. There was also a tour of the school.

18.01.2024 - participation in the Pärnu LV Inclusive education discussion seminar, where during the discussion information was shared about the vision of the newly created competence center (the role, services and partners of the competence center were discussed). During the group work, there was an opportunity to introduce the goals and content of the vocational selection curriculum, which was very interested. The meeting led to further cooperation (the possibility of implementing a vocational curriculum for students of Pärnu County schools) with Pärnu County Municipalities and Pärnu LV. Representatives of Pärnu County schools, Pärnu Learning Counseling Center, Rajaleidja, Pärnu City Government participated.
